## **Guidelines for the 2013 George Platt Scholarship Program**

Following are the guidelines for the ISA Los Angeles (ISALA) Section Scholarship program for the 2014-2015 academic school years, as approved by the ISALA Board of Directors.

- 1. Scholarships are awarded to successful applicants who will attend an accredited technical school, college or university as an undergraduate in the Fall 2014 and/or Spring 2015 terms as a full-time student pursuing a minimum of 12 credit hours per term.
- 2. Any ISA student member of ISA Los Angeles Section, ISA Cal Poly Student Section, ISA Long Beach State Student Committee, and immediate relatives of any ISA Los Angeles member may apply. Other students may apply by submitting a completed ISA membership application with their scholarship application. If already a member of another ISA Section, applicant must transfer membership to the ISA Los Angeles Section prior to submitting application package.
- 3. Applicant must submit an essay of no less than 500 words (typed) describing his/her future goals and the contribution that a scholarship would make in achieving those goals.
- 4. Applicant must not be a recipient of any other ISALA scholarships in the current or previous fiscal year. The ISALA scholarship will not be awarded to the same person in consecutive years.
- 5. The applicant must submit an official copy of his/her recent high school or college transcript.
- 6. The applicant must submit a letter of recommendation from an individual familiar with the student (e.g. a teacher, coach or minister) but not related (not a family member or guardian) to him/her.
- 7. The applicant must submit a completed paper copy of ISA membership application (if not yet a member). The ISALA Section will process the application and pay for the first year's dues for all scholarship applicants.
- 8. The applicant and nominating party are encouraged to attend the scholarship award meeting of the ISALA (Location and date to be announced).
- 9. All scholarship payments will be submitted directly to the college or university where the scholarship recipient is enrolled to pay for normal tuition, enrollment fees and/or textbooks for the specified school year.

## **Deadline for Application**

To be considered, all applications must be submitted no later than May 14, 2014, and all supporting documents must be received no later than June 2, 2014.

Scholarships will be awarded to applicants based upon the quality of essay, high school or college grades, accomplishments and, the recommendation letter.
